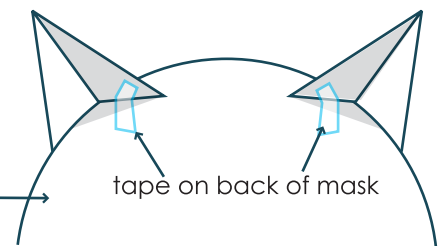




**INSTRUCTIONS:**

- print mask on **CARDSTOCK**. you'll want a thicker paper to hold up to folding **AND** bat-antics.
- use a craft blade (like an x-acto knife) to gently score the dotted lines.
- use the craft blade or scissors to cut out the mask **AND** the eye holes. you need to be able to see to fight crime.
- where you've scored along the dotted lines, fold the mask to start shaping it.
- to make the ears extra batty, tuck the free end behind the mask and tape down the edge like so. —————→
- if you're so inclined, tape 2 pieces of elastic or string to the back of the mask so you can securely tie it behind your head... or tape a dowel to one side so you can parade around like it's a set of opera glasses.
- fight crime.
